Collaborative Outreach Preventing Exploitation (COPE)



Purpose

The Collaborative Outreach Preventing Exploitation (COPE) Program supports youth aged 12-24, who are at risk of, or engaged in sexual exploitation within Central Alberta. This voluntary program helps youth, and their families reduce the risks of sexual exploitation in the community and online.

COPE provides both 1-1 supports for youth and families and education within the community to build awareness on personal safety, healthy relationships, sexual exploitation and online safety.

COPE Education Series is offered to schools, professionals, organizations and community members to increase awareness and knowledge on Sexual Exploitation, Online Safety, Healthy Relationships and Resources.

Referral Process

Any one can refer to the program including guardians, youth, professionals, teachers etc.

The referral form can be provided through email or completed by calling 1 (800) 743-6179. Youth under 16 require guardian approval however if this is a barrier, please let the person completing the referral know.

Outcomes

To provide support and education to lower the risks of sexual exploitation of and increase awareness, knowledge and safety within the community.
