Babysitter Course through the *Canadian Safety Council* for students age 12 years and up and consists of 5-2 hour sessions plus an exam on the last day.

The program enables the participants to demonstrate their capabilities and maturity by completing the course under the responsible direction of the instructor. Students must attend all 5 sessions and pass the exam to be certified.

Home Alone through the *Canadian Safety Council* for students 10-12 years of age.

This 3 hour course is designed to provide children with the necessary skills and knowledge to be safe and responsible when home alone for short periods of time. It will help them understand how to prevent problems, handle real-life situations and keep themselves safe and constructively occupied.

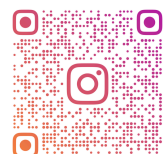
